Registrations:

First-Time Master Plumber (Registration/License)	\$200.00
Master Plumber Renewal	\$125.00
Inactive Master Plumber	\$ 65.00
Journeyman Plumber	\$ 50.00
Apprentice Plumber	\$ 25.00
Sewer Tapper Test	\$ 40.00
Sewer Tapper	\$ 40.00
Maintenance Plumber	\$ 65.00

Note: If you do not renew your registration by January 31 of the following year, your registration will be considered a first time registration.

Water/Sewer Line-New and Replacement:

Residential 1' – 100' = \$30 + \$1 per lineal over 100' (cap at \$130)
Commercial 1' – 100' = \$50 + \$1 per lineal over 100' (cap at \$150)

Commercial Plan Approval:

1-20 Fixtures	= \$40
21-40 Fixtures	= \$60
41-60 Fixtures	= \$80
61-100 Fixtures	= \$100
100+ Fixtures	= \$150

Residential:	Permit Fee:	\$30
	Fixture Fee:	\$10
Commercial	Permit Fee:	\$50
	Fixture Fee:	\$12

<i>Backflow test report filing fee</i>	\$10
<i>Water heater/softener replacement</i>	\$20

Total number of inspections on commercial permits authorized prior to an additional fee:

Permit Costs:	Inspections:
\$200 - \$500	8
\$501 - \$750	10
\$751 - \$1,000	12
Multiples of \$1,000	10 per \$1,000

Re-Inspection fees for Code Violations or Contractor Unprepared are \$100 per re-inspection.

Penalty for starting work without a permit:

Residential	\$30 & 25% of permit costs
Commercial	\$50 & 25% of permit costs

After hour inspections:

Inspections conducted outside normal working hours per hour portal to portal = \$50.00.
