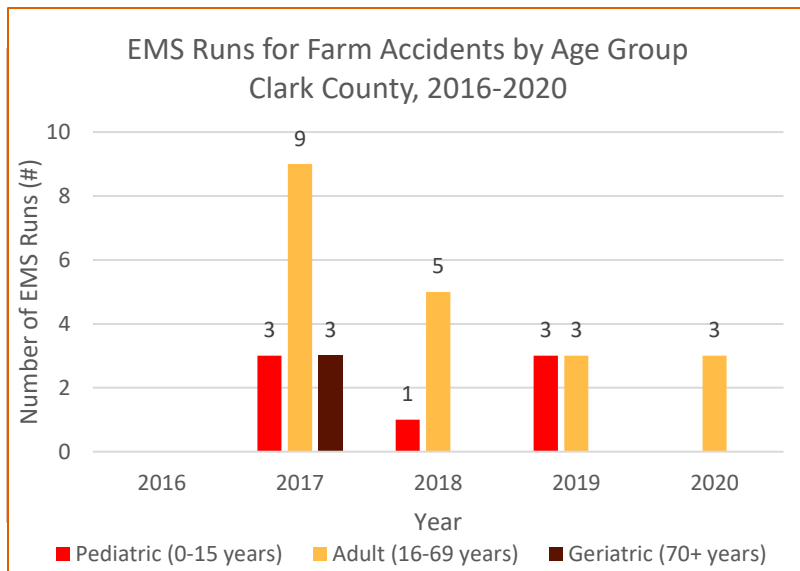
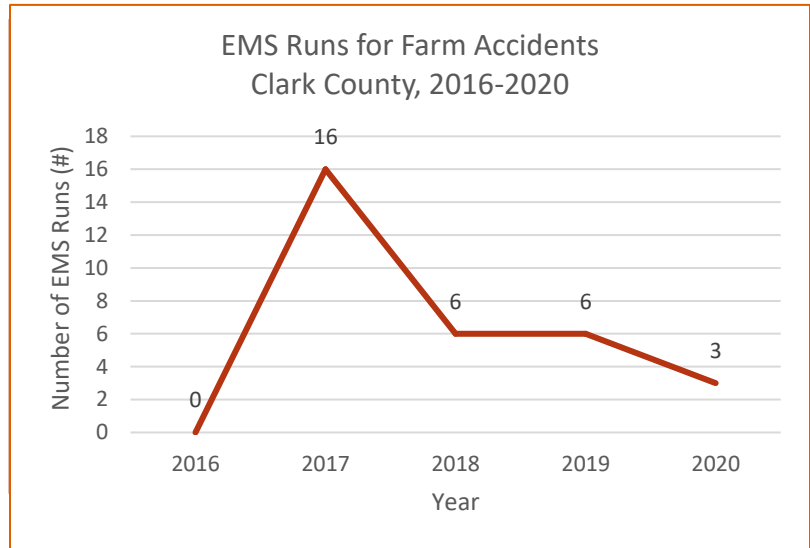


Farm Accident Related EMS Runs: Clark County 2016-2020

All the data was acquired from the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services. The Ohio Department of Public Safety specifically disclaims responsibility for any analysis, interpretations, or conclusions.

Farm accident related EMS runs in Clark County peaked in 2017 with 16 EMS runs. The amount of farm accident related EMS runs has decreased 81.25% from 2017-2020.



Adults (16-69 years old) are the majority of individuals who are involved in farm accident related EMS runs. In 2017, adults consisted of 60% of all farm accident related EMS runs. The only year where adults were not the majority of EMS runs was 2019; adults and pediatric (0-15 years old) both consisted of 50% of cases.

Farm accident by type is very dependent on the year. In 2017 the majority (43.75%) of farm accidents that occurred were a fall of some sort. In 2019 the majority (66.67%) of farm accidents that occurred were caused by a farm vehicle/aircraft.
