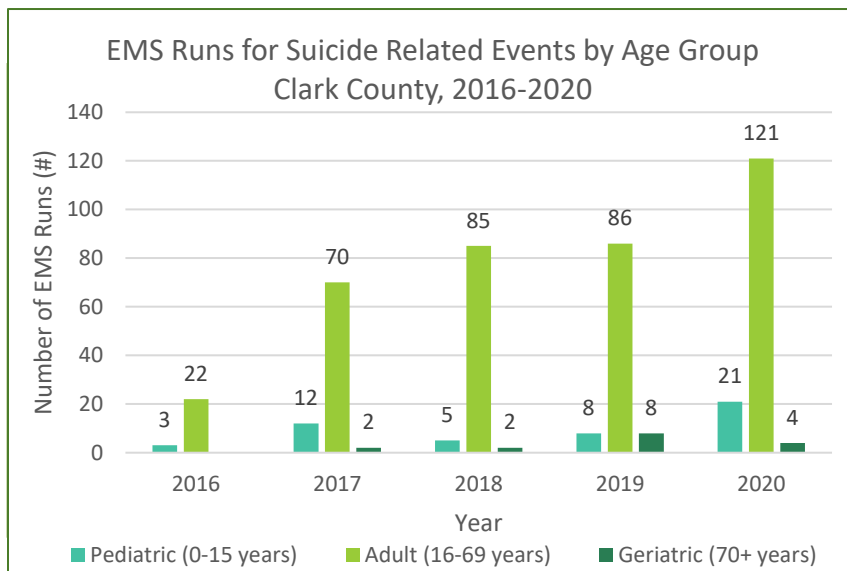
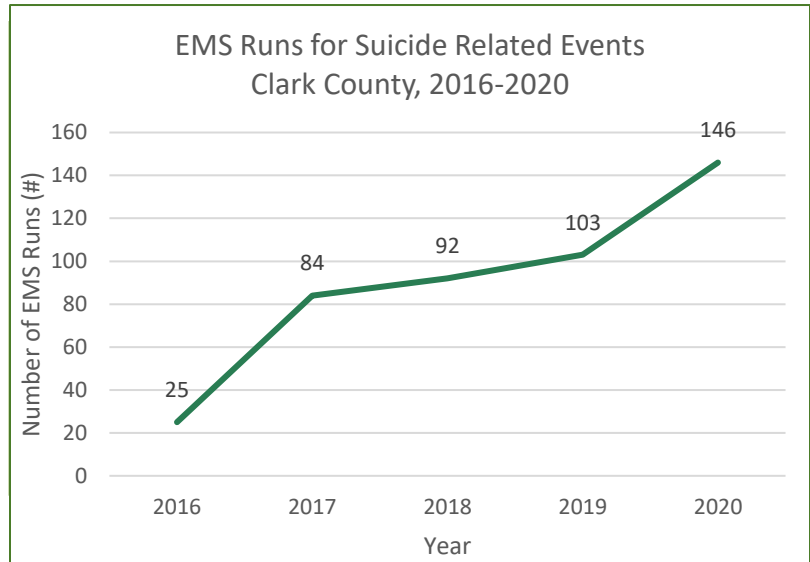


Suicide Related EMS Runs: Clark County 2016-2020

All the data was acquired from the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services. The Ohio Department of Public Safety specifically disclaims responsibility for any analysis, interpretations, or conclusions.

Suicide related EMS events in Clark County have been increasing since 2016 with the highest number of EMS runs (146) in 2020. The amount of suicide related events has increased 484.0% from 2016-2020.



Adults (16-69 years old) are the majority of individuals who are involved in suicide related EMS events. Pediatric (0-15 years old) is the second highest age group involved in suicide related EMS events. Except in 2019, pediatric and geriatric (70+ years old) were both the second highest.

Suicide related EMS events by type of suicide event has changed since 2016. From 2016-2018 suicide attempts were the majority of suicide EMS runs but then decreased in 2019-2020. Suicide ideation began increasing from 2017-2018 then was the majority of suicide EMS runs from 2019-2020.
